

Data Protection Information

1. Information on the collection of personal data as part of the program support of the BMWi funding program "Biomass Energy Use"

- 1.1. In the following we inform you about the collection and processing of personal data in the form of photographs, sound and image recordings within the scope of events. Personal data (Art. 4 No. 1 EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), hereinafter referred to as "GDPR") are all data that can be related to you personally, e.g. photos, name, address, e-mail address.

- 1.4. The responsible department within the DBFZ German Biomass Research Centre non-profit limited company is the public relations department and the program support of the BMWi funding program "Biomass Energy Use" in the field of bioenergy systems.

2. Purpose and duration of data collection

- 2.1. Your personal data will be processed for enquires of the following purposes:
 - Presentation of the BMWi funding program "Biomass Energy Use" and the topic of bioenergy / renewable energies to the outside world.
 - Presentation of the activities of the BMWi research network Bioenergy
 - Actor/participant support and acquisition
 - Increase of the internet and media presence
 - Citizen-friendly appearance
- 2.2. Data processing takes place on the basis of your consent in accordance with Art. 6 Para. 1 S.1 a) GDPR. The lawfulness of the processing for specified purposes is given with a consent. Apart from information on the event, venue, photos and, if applicable, sound and image

recordings, no other personal data, such as the names of the affected persons, will be published without consent or legal basis.

3. Your Rights

3.1. As the data subject, you have the following rights vis-à-vis the DBFZ as the responsible body with regard to the personal data relating to you (Art. 13 et seq. GDPR):

- Right of access,
- Right to rectification or deletion,
- Right to Informal Revocation of Consent,
- Right to limit the processing, right to object to the processing,
- Right to data transferability,
- Right to complain to a data protection supervisory authority about the processing of your personal data by the DBFZ

3.2. If we base the processing of your personal data on a weighing of interests within the meaning of Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 f) GDPR, you may object to the processing. In the event of such an objection, we ask you to explain the reasons why we should not process your personal data as we have done. In the event of your justified objection, we will examine the facts and either discontinue or adapt the data processing or point out our compelling reasons worthy of protection on the basis of which we will continue the processing.

5. Deletion of personal data
